

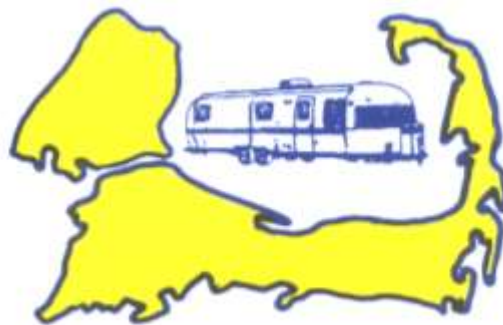

We also have a very special rally in

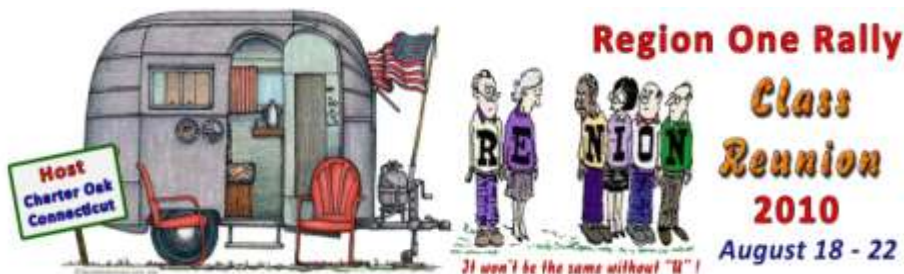

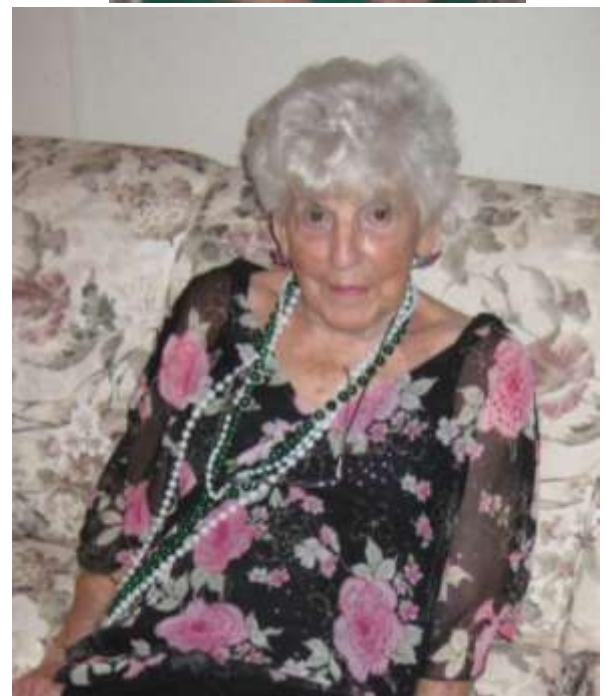
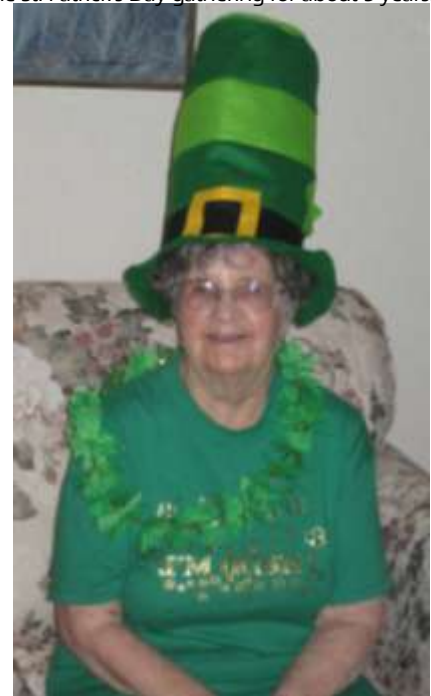
